## **Contents of Energy Folder**

There are 12 folders inside of the Energy folder. Each folder contains a PowerPoint slide deck. The slide deck can be used as a PowerPoint or be imported into Google Slides. The folder also contains a PDF and Microsoft Word version of the Lesson Notes. Finally, there is an **Images** folder inside each of the folders. The images folder contains animations (usually .gif or .mp4), movies (usually .mp4), and graphics (usually .png) used in the slide deck. Often times there is a Microsoft Word document that contains the source of one or more line graphics. The availability of the MS Word document will allow teachers to manipulate any of the graphics as desired. All the images included in the PowerPoint slide deck are not necessarily saved in the Images folder. They can be edited within PowerPoint or Google Slides (if needed).
